Curriculum

Over the 21 months of the OneMBA Program, professionals and executives must take 10 required courses (five globally coordinated courses and five regionally coordinated courses) and four Global Residencies.

During Residencies, OneMBA professionals and executives from all of the partner universities gather to visit local and multinational businesses, meet with respected business leaders in the region and enjoy cultural and social events.

In the meantime, participants are exposed to key issues and business practices in markets across the world, learn to apply new tools and skills both locally and globally and build their cross-cultural business skills as they work with other executives on virtual projects.
